

#### Sixth Sunday of Easter Reflection - Sr. Joanne Delehanty

Lent is marked by forty days. A long time. Easter is celebrated with fifty days. A longer time. Deliberately making a point about where victory lies.

Where do we keep meeting the resurrected Christ? Today's Gospel offers one answer.

Look at the words that describe God's behaviors toward us:

- •Be with you always
- •Remain with you
- Not leave you
- Come to you
- Will reveal myself

And then remember: Resurrection was realized by **presence**, not by the empty tomb. Those phrases remind us that God's presence to us is unqualified, unrestricted, absolutely committed, and personal. Lean into that. Nurture your awareness of God's presence within you. And remember further: We are charged with appropriating those behaviors, too. For we must let ourselves be transformed by our experience of God's presence, and express it in our own interactions with The second reading tells us why. The purpose of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection was "that he might lead you to God." We are called to join that effort. Our lives, our ways of being present to one another, can lead others to God, and bring us together to everlasting life.
