27th Sunday in Ordinary Time Reflection by Sr Joanne Delehanty, OP

The reading from the letter to the Philippians speaks appealingly of having no anxiety and having the peace of God guard our hearts and minds. Lovely thought!

We often think of peace in terms of passivity and quietude. But the letter to the Philippians connects peace to some virtues: truth, honor, justice, purity, beauty, graciousness. Virtues require living, not just thinking or studying. By these actions, chosen over and over again, we accept the invitation to participate in God's own life, God's way of engaging with glorious creation, and living into the Kingdom.

"Keep on doing what you have learned and received and heard and seen..." wrote Paul. We are to help create peace by being peace and bringing peace, reflecting that "peace of God that surpasses all understanding and guards our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus." Brother David Steindl-Rast wrote: "Only if we become calm as earth, fluid as water, and blazing as fire will we be able to rise to the task of peacemaking."

Now that's a tall order! But soooooo possible! We have our work cut out for us! On your marks....
