# 23nd Sunday in Ordinary Time - Reflection by Sr Joanne Delehanty, OP



There is something about numbers. We like counting. We fill our lives with counting: salaries, weight, cost of living, gas mileage, sacraments, Beatitudes, even Sundays in Ordinary Time. We have come to believe life is measureable somehow. We're like that. But God?

Today's responsorial psalm refrain: "If today you hear God's voice, harden not your heart."

**If** you hear God's voice... Notice the condition is not on God's communication. It is on our listening. Today. And each day. Faithfully attending to the ever-present God-with-us. Protecting that holy connection that is our source of life and reason for existence, which we dare to call communion.

Divinity is within us and all around us, yet we are blind and deaf to it so much of the time. We think in such small ways. God doesn't. God is lavish in loving us: prodigal, expansive, tireless. Prayer connects us to the One who loves us endlessly. Mirabai Starr writes: "You sit down to meditate not only because it helps you to find rest in the arms of the formless Beloved but also because it increases your chances of being stunned by beauty when you get back up."

We are not stunned by beauty with hardened hearts, hearts that are defensive, decided, planned, sure, and isolated. We have become people who look for things instead of seeing what the world so generously offers always.

What do we do about hearts that are hardened? We must deliberately ask for and choose the grace to be pliable, poised, on tiptoe, expectant, awake, receptive...ever seeking to broaden our minds and hearts and spirits. Life is not a method or matter of willpower. Nor is it an accumulation of goals, objectives, and achievements. Life is a witness to the never-ending revelation of the divine, the endless accessibility of the sacred that makes us and the entire world sacramental.

Thomas Merton: "If we could let go of our own obsession with what we think is the meaning of it all, we might be able to hear (God's) call and follow (Him) in (His) mysterious cosmic dance."

"If today you hear God's voice, harden not your heart." We have our holy work cut out for us. And it is pure joy!




